[IC 54] A BEAUTIFUL CATARACT SURGERY DONE AND YET PATIENT IS NOT HAPPY



Cataract surgery with iol implantation is usually a visually gratifying surgery, yet sometimes the patient feels that something was not right especially when he develops some of the symptoms listed below. Common postoperative problems include flashes and floaters due to posterior vitreous detachment, reduced vision due to cystoid macular edema, problems of foreign body sensation and grittiness due to dry eye and sometimes headache due to rise in iop. Sometimes when the refraction is done there can be a refractive surprise. These problems often create a mismatch between the patients expectations and a good surgical outcome. In this IC we shall discuss these common post cataract surgery problems, how to reduce their incidence and their management.





Keratoconus is characterized by progressive corneal thinning with resultant irregular astigmatism and myopia. Inspite of the massive technological advancements in the diagnosis and management of Keratoconus, there is still a palpable discrepancy in the preferred practice protocols for treatments. [IC 19] -Low Vision Aids - A Ray Of Hope For Visually **Impaired**



There are an estimated 4.95 million people blind (0.36% of the total population), 35 million people visually impaired (2.55%).Low vision though not categorized as blindness per se, has enormous social and economic implications in terms of economic loss and loss of productivity. Reports indicate that only 3% of all blind and visually impaired children in developing countries have access to basic low vision care. The major limitations are lack of emphasis on low vision in existing eye care programme, non-availability of good quality low vision training programs. To tackle this problem, it is very necessary to carry out low vision instruction courses. It will cover introduction, various causes, assessment, discussion about various optical and non-optical devices, setting up low vision clinic and measures to improve the access to low vision services. Thus early management and provision of aids will help them cope with their daily needs as well as social needs
